Conditions of Entry



This tournament is conducted under the auspices of the New South Wales Veteran Golfers Association

Eligibility.

To play in the PMQ Open Vets Tournament, all players must

- (a) Have attained the age of 55 years as of the first day of the tournament.
- (b) Hold current membership of a registered Golf Club.
- (c) Hold a current Golf Australia handicap.
- (d) Be a member of the NSWVGA

The participating player, before commencing play at an event, may be required to present identification. Any player failing to meet these requirements will be refused entry to the Tournament. Any player who is not a registered member of the NSWVGA may pay a \$5 joining fee to the Tournament Director before starting play and they will be registered.

FORMAT: The tournament will be played over 36 holes (Stableford) with 18 holes on each day. Each player will be play off his/her handicap of the day relevant to the Course and Tee of the day.

Men handicap limit 36.

Ladies handicap limit 45.

Players with handicaps higher than the published limit, may be accepted to play, although they will play off the maximum handicaps of the competition.

Daily Competitions for PMGC Members will be separate to those of the visiting Players, although the 36 Hole Competition will be "all in". Prize values will be consistent through each competition.

Grades for the daily event will be consistent with the number of entries.

The grades for the 36hole event will be 3 grades for Men and 2 Grades for Women (numbers divided equally between the grades)

The Match Committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps during the competition.

TROPHIES:

Open Tournament Trophies

No player may win more than one trophy during the two days.

NSWVGA Trophy.

The NSWVGA donated trophies will be awarded to the men's and women's winner, second and third placings of the Tuesday 18hole event. Players must play both days to qualify for this Trophy.

Tied scores: Winners will be decided on countback.
